*Summer is upon us and we need to discuss HEARTWORM DISEASE in dogs*



*Commons misconceptions:*

• My dog doesn't have heartworm disease because there is no worms in his stools: WRONG  
Heartworms live in your dog's heart, lungs and major blood vessels, there is no heartworm in his intestinal tract so no worms in the stools.

• My dog stays in my backyard so he is not exposed to heartworms: WRONG

Mosquitoes transmits heartworms by biting an infected host (another dog, fox, coyote) and then bite your dog. Mosquitoes are not stopped by fences.

• My pet is healthy, I would know if he had worms in his heart: WRONG

It can take several years before any signs of heartworm disease is noted. Heartworms can live 5-7 years in a dog's heart. Often signs of coughing, exercise intolerance shows when the disease is more advanced.

*What to do to protect your dog:*

The great news is that heartworm prevention is an effective way to prevent heartworms and other intestinal worms that your pet could contract.

Prevention is key- speak to your veterinarian about testing your dog for heartworm disease and have him started on monthly prevention.

# Dominion City Brewing Company will be at FunFair

Four years ago it would have been hard to imagine that an industrial unit on Beacon Hill's Canotek Road would become a destination for delicious artisanal beer and locally-sourced food. Today, a short trip to Dominion City Brewing Co. proves what can happen when a community gets behind their local brewery.

"Dominion City has always felt like a community-built brewery," says co-founder Josh McJannett. "The core of our success has always been building a relationship with the people who live and work here in the East End."

Dominion City has established a reputation for boundary-pushing beer that spans the gamut from easy-drinking blonde ales and elegant lagers to complex farmhouse ales, hazy IPAs and experimental beers like ice cream stouts and even a recent key lime lactose pale ale. Despite the fact their beer has earned a reputation for quality province-wide and now pours in more than 100 beer-focussed bars from Ottawa to London, the focus remains on keeping it local.

"Our vision is to brew the most delicious beer we can and to have as direct a relationship with our customers as we can," says McJannett. "Sharing what we brew directly from the brewery means you get the freshest beer possible and everytime you come back there's something new to try."

On any given day you'll find dozens of people enjoying a glass of one of the brewery's dozen draught beers and enjoying a quick game of Jenga while snacking on house-made eats like grilled cheese sandwiches, chips and dip and even a highbrow take on that 90s classic, the pizza pop.

Beyond their regular offering, the brewery regularly hosts some of the city's best chefs through a pop-up brewery kitchen series that's attracted names like the Whalesbone, Coconut Lagoon, town and North & Navy to the east end. Hosted one Friday per month the events operate almost like an indoor foodtruck and pair delicious food with great music and very good beer. Dominion City has plans to open a patio amongst a small patch of trees on the property this Summer.

Dominion City has partnered to be the beer sponsor for the Blackburn Hamlet FunFair (June 1-3). The brewery's bottleshop and tasting bar is open seven days a week from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m.

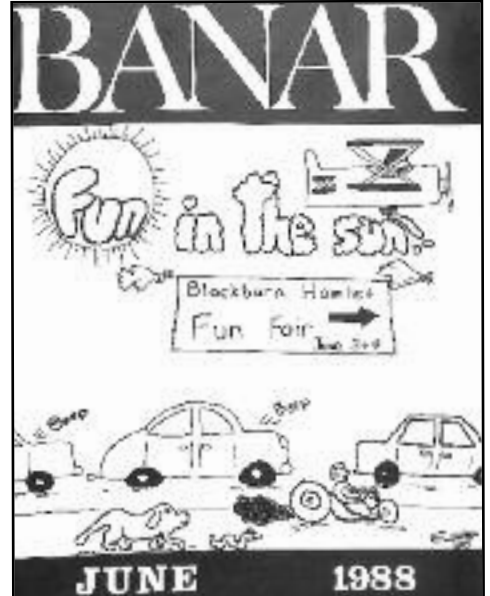

# Learning to Cycle Safely in the Hamlet

## *Our Community Bike Skills Development Day*

As a parent and council member at Good Shepherd School, I have the good fortune of representing the School Active Transport Initiative to our student population. This endeavour promotes among our students safe and healthy physical activity such as walking and biking to school, school walking clubs and the introduction of the Walking School Bus. This year, Good Shepherd had planned to hold a bike skills development day for our students in June but amended this vision when Laura Dudas, BCA President and school council member, informed me that the BCA was also planning a Bike Rodeo event. We realized that a

merger was definitely in order! I contacted John Balint of the BCA's Environment and Transportation Committee and we expanded the event to include three Blackburn Hamlet schools: Good Shepherd School, Ecole Ste. Marie and Glen Ogilvie Public School.

Enthusiastic parent representatives from each school came on board and by March we had developed a solid vision for the upcoming Bike Skills Development Day.

Key to the project was Trish Cochrane, a biking coach and Ottawa Safety Council member. She organized the event into six stations, each focusing on different required bike skills such as Stop and Start, Straight Line Riding, Hand Signals, Crosswalks and

Pathways. Also included were bike and helmet checkpoints and a fun station where children could practice inflating inner tubes. We added a rest area where younger children could sit and colour while their older siblings completed the course.

Children in Grades 2-5 who were comfortable riding a bike unassisted were invited to attend with the requirement of a proper fitting helmet and sturdy, closed-toe shoes and that parents stay on site for the duration of their child's session. Adult volunteers join us through the school communities, and also secondary school students wanting to earn volunteer hours were welcomed and appreciated.

And all registrants received a colourful certificate of achievement in recognition of their hard work.

In all, about 40 children enjoyed the Bike Skills Day, with about the same number of volunteers. We are now in the process of reviewing both positive and negative aspects of the event with the goal of doing even better next year. Of one thing we are certain—this was an extremely worthwhile initiative and a great investment in the practical cycling knowledge of our local young people.

*The Burgess Boys* by Elizabeth Strout. This was my favourite novel this year. It tells the story of two brothers who return home to help their sister with a family crisis. Strout writes beautifully while telling captivating stories about very human characters who resonate with the reader.

*Forgiveness* by Mark Sakamoto. This book won the CBC Canada Reads this year. Pieced together through Sakamoto's interviews with his maternal grandmother, Mitsue Sakamoto, and paternal grandfather, Ralph MacLean, these wartime recollections from contrasting sides of a human tragedy offer a unique perspective on the idea of a Canadian family. It also links two families together through compassion and understanding, which is the stimulus for Sakamoto's own process of recovery.

*Delighting in the Law of the Lord* by Jerram Barrs. Most people, Christians included, think that the Old Testament laws are irrelevant in the 21st century. Barrs shows us, in winsome prose, how God's law, understood through the grace released in Jesus Christ, is the best guide we could find.

*The Bible*. The best selling book every year because it's such a good book! For first-time readers, I recommend the *New Living Translation* or *The Message* - much easier to understand than the *King James Version*.
