People of all ages will dance with it, look through it, and photograph themselves as part of it. “Hamlet Dancing” will stimulate memories, create wishes and dreams, or simply create a smile.

It will be almost 8 ft. tall and 10 ft. long and forms a gentle curve. The base will be underground so the figures appear to be dancing on the grass.

The positive connecting of people, nature, and the illusive great mysteries we contemplate, is the subject matter I work with in my practice. This often is reflected in what we make or build as a people. This setting attracts my interest to submit a piece that delves into this and connects to the viewers.
