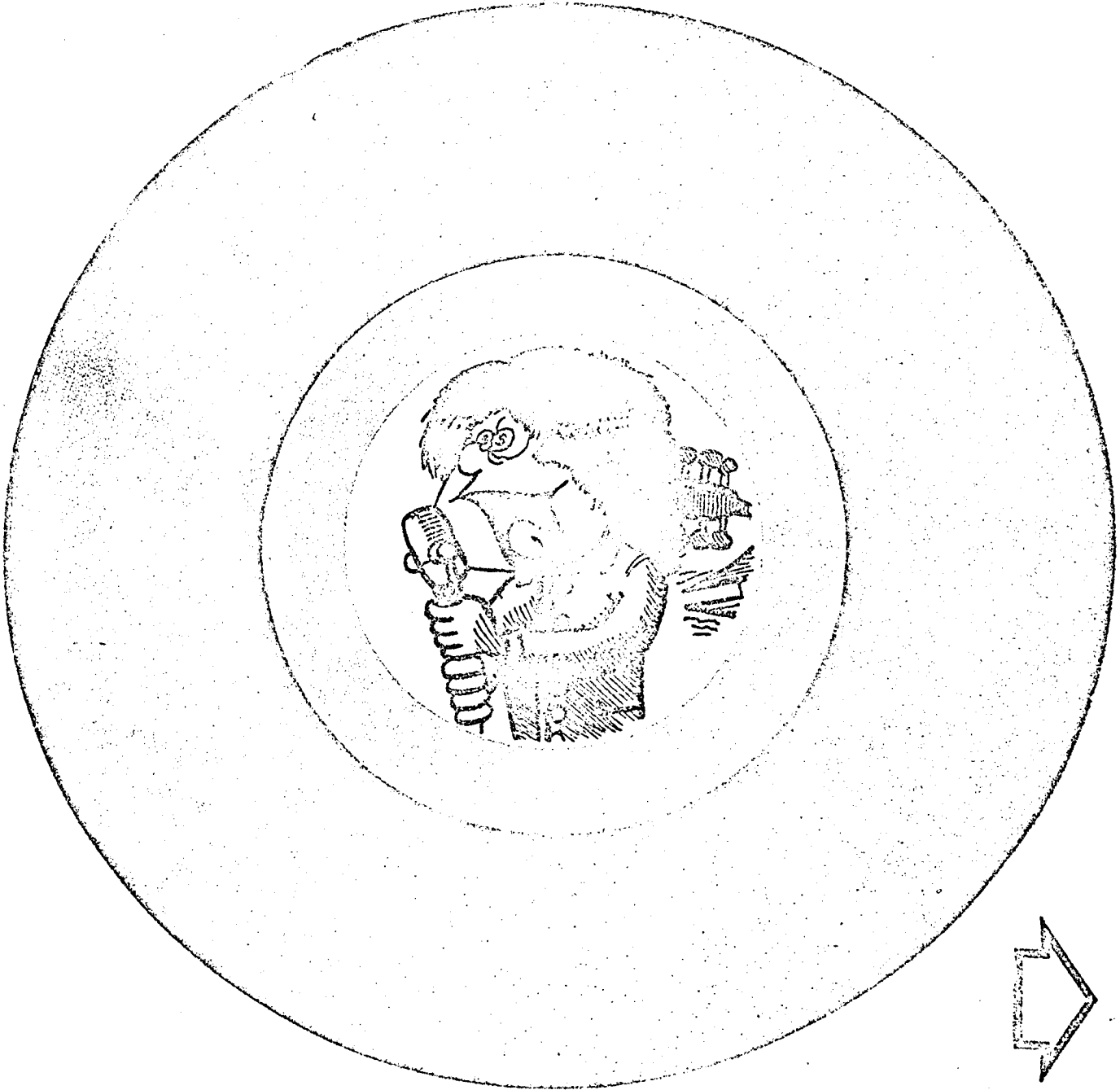

This will include outdoor facilities such as skating rinks, baseball fields and related recreation areas. If we are successful, we may also be in a position to enter a Midget team (boys 14 to 16) in the Greenbelt League.
