The planning office of our school board has decided to establish an English primary school, consisting of the first four school years (grades 1, 2, 3 and 4 ) at Ste-Marie School for 1969-70 if the student population warrants it. Registration for this purpose will take place on May 13th and 14th, 1:00 to 3:30 p.m. as mentioned above.

Closer to the end of June all parents will be informed of the decision. If there are enough pupils for the primary classes, the English school will be established. If not, the primary pupils will be bussed in to the nearest English Catholic school which is presently under construction in Beacon Hill North. In either case the pupils from grade 4 to grade 8 inclusive will be transported to this new school in Beacon Hill North.

The parents of children presently attending St. Gabriel's School and those who have already registered for 1969-70 need not re-register on May 13th, 1969.

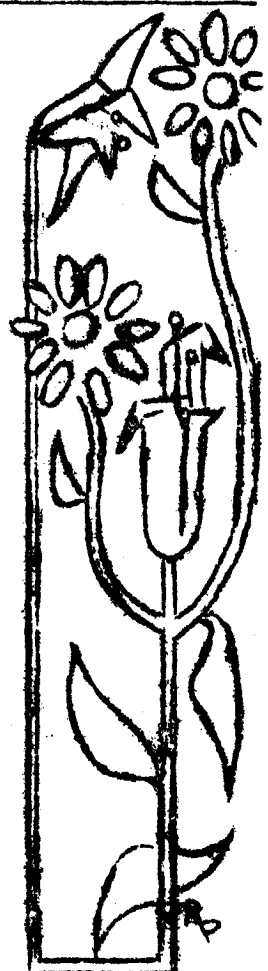
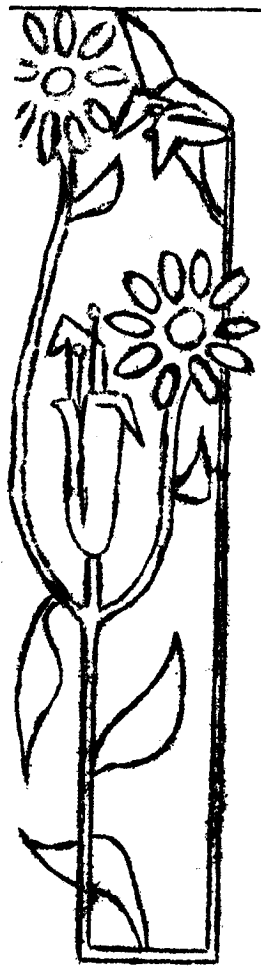

So far, negotiations with Costain have been unsuccessful and our request to the School Board three months ago for use of part of the school grounds has not even been acknowledged.

Your committee is continuing its efforts and, hopefully, a solution to the land problem will be found in the near future.
