### OUTDOOR HOCKEY

Once again the Blackburn Outdoor Hockey League will swing into operation as soon as the rinks are ready. The following points should be noted:

- a) Registration Fee - \$1.00
- b) Registration Time - Sat. Nov. 28 9 am - 1:00 pm.  
Sat. Dec. 5 9 am - 1:00 pm.

c) Registration Place - Glen Ogilvie Public School

d) Ages - 6 years to 14 years inclusive on Jan. 1, 1971. Note: Inclusion of six year olds is on an experimental basis. If there is insufficient registration to form an appropriate league the registration fee will be refunded.

This outdoor league is designed to provide organized hockey for boys unable to play or not wishing to play in the indoor leagues and also for beginners of all ages. Registration will therefore be restricted to those boys NOT playing in indoor leagues.

Games were played last year on Sunday afternoons and Tuesday and Thursday evenings at the St. Marie and Blackburn Public School rinks. Times and places might have to change but a similar arrangement will be followed this year.

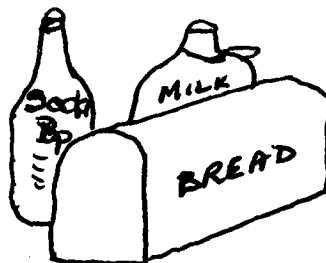

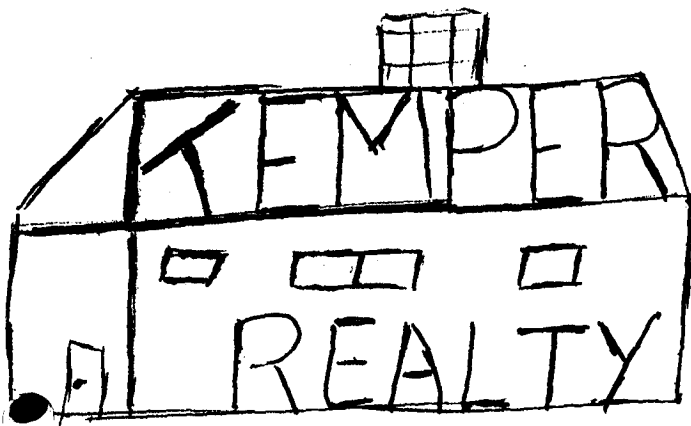
