The flyer that came to your homes in mid-August described generally some of the proposed projects for development, as well as the sources of funds. The meeting on September 15th will focus on the allocation of these funds to the projects. As well, we will discuss the priorities of the Community for these developments.

The projects, in our suggested order of priority are:

	<u>Estimated Total Cost</u>
1. An extension to the swimming pool area by adding a 30' by 23' junior pool and enclosed relaxation area;	\$ 30,000
2. Two additional tennis courts located north of the green shack using some land to be leased from the Separate School Board;	40,000
3. Play structures and facilities in a number of parks and leased green areas: Keystone, Orient Park, Tauvette, Red Maple, Ecole Ste. Marie, Southpark, Valewood;	35,000
4. Improvements to ball diamonds in Bearbrook Park and the senior field in Tauvette, including outfield fencing and bleachers (Bearbrook only);	10,000
5. Improvements to lighting in Bearbrook Park and some lighting in others;	5,000
6. Improved landscaping in Tauvette, Bearbrook, Red Maple, Orient Park;	10,000
7. Basketball/Volleyball facilities incorporated into outdoor hockey rink in Bearbrook Park;	3,000
8. Improvements to existing tennis courts by upgrading lighting and a windbreaker; and,	15,000
9. A Community Center for general purpose use in Bearbrook Park.	<u>47,000</u>
TOTAL	\$195,000

NOTE: Construction of these projects will not increase taxes.
