# Blackburn Community Association Meeting Minutes April 18, 2024 7:30 pm

- 1. Call to order at 7:35pm
- 2. Motion to approve agenda by Brent Lawrie. Seconded by Satinder Sahota. Carried.
- 3. Minutes from previous meetings
  - Motion to approve the minutes from February 15, 2024 by Lisa Margeson. Seconded by Brent Lawrie. Carried.
- 4. Community Update (Councillor Dudas)
  - The new advanced left turn light into Lois Riel Secondary School will be installed this summer.
  - The flex posts have been reinstalled on Innes Road. The Bearbrook posts will be installed soon and will include new posts from Westpark to Hornets nest. Councillor Dudas would appreciate receiving feedback on these to determine if they are effective or not.
  - Residents are encouraged to use the Sunday On-Demand Transit pilot. OCTranspo is still working out some issues with the application vendor so that the pilot can be expanded to include Saturdays.
  - The OCTranspo Route Review will not only resulted in the removal of service on Tauvette and Southpark, it will also remove service from Northpark, Ridgeburn and Eastpark as these stops were seeing very limited use. The 28 service will be replaced by the extended route 24 which will travel along Westpark, Bearbrook and Innes before routing to the Chappel Hill South Park and Ride.

  - Satinder Sahota, Jeff Miller and Mélanie Mathieu will present a draft at the May board meeting. If needed, a final version will be presented at the June board meeting.

- 16. Safety (Don Kelly)
  - On April 6 a First Aid /CPR course was held in the Theatre of the Blackburn Retirement Residence. Sixteen people successfully completed the course. April 6. The course was instructed by Paul Needham of the PSMK First Aid Training Inc. A letter of appreciation will be sent to the Aspira Retirement Living Company on behalf of the BCA for their community support. Two more courses are planned for this year.
  - On April 8 Brad Hampson and Don Kelly made a presentation to the Ottawa Neighborhood Watch (ONW). ONW coordinates the Neighborhood Watch Programs for the City of Ottawa. ONW were briefed on the Blackburn NW and the concept of integrating the NW program into the Emergency Preparedness Plan. We are the first community association to explore this idea.

- On May 16 BCA Safety will be holding a community event at the Hall where we will be presenting a written document of the Blackburn Emergency Preparedness Plan. Promotion of the event will include notices on social media and a poster. A written plan will be published in advance of the meeting and open to feedback from BCA Board.

- The Arena showcase contract has been funded and the display cabinet should be ready by the end of May.
