- commercial and for-profit organizations or projects;
- politically affiliated organizations or projects;
- religious institutions or related events.

Please submit this completed application to grants@blackburnhamlet.ca. Applicants are encouraged to present their project at a monthly board meeting to answer questions before a decision is made. Your application will be reviewed by the BCA Board of Directors and the funding request will be approved or denied. Preference may be given to organizations that did not receive funding in the preceding year.
